

Seven Oaks Campground Rules

General Rules, Information & Fees

- No Refunds - Camp fee is \$5 per night per person (children 5 and under free)
- Visitors must leave the campgrounds by 10 PM
- Scouts camp free
- Camp facilities include tables, fire pits & toilets with flush toilets and showers available in the lodge 24-hours a day
- Firewood is available at the office for \$5 per bundle
- All campers must sign a rental/indemnification agreement prior to set up.
- Camping is only allowed in designated camp sites.
- Seven Oaks Campground Management reserves the right to evict, without prior notice, anyone who in our opinion is creating a disturbance, being a nuisance or being non-compliant with Seven Oaks Campground Rules.
- Abuse of drugs will be cause for immediate eviction.
- Fireworks, weapons, power generators and chainsaws are strictly prohibited at all times.

Pets

- Friendly pets welcome provided they present NO hardship to other guests
- All pets must be on a short leash at all times with an adult AND YOU are required to clean up after your pets.

Quiet Hours - Shhhhh - If you can hear it away from your site...It's too loud!

- Quiet hours are from 11 PM to 8 AM
- Everyone should be at an occupied site by quiet hours
- All radios/stereos must be turned off during quiet hours
- No loud talking during quiet hours
- Children under 18 must be at their campsite during quiet hours unless with an adult

Vehicles

- Speed limit for motorized vehicles is 5 MPH.
- Watch for and yield to bicyclists, children and other pedestrians.
- All vehicles must be parked in designated areas
- No ATV's or motorized bikes are allowed in the campgrounds

Alcohol Consumption

- Consumption of alcoholic beverages must be confined to YOUR site
- Underage consumption of alcoholic beverages is not permitted.
- Excessive use of alcohol will be cause for immediate eviction.

Campfires and Firewood

- DO NOT bring firewood to Seven Oaks. Firewood can harbor many invasive pests and diseases that are harmful to trees and forests. The spread of the Emerald Ash Borer has been done primarily through the movement of firewood.
- Campfires are permitted only in designated fire rings.
- Keep Fires to a reasonable size and extinguish all fires before leaving or retiring for the evening.
- You may scavenge wood in the forest but do NOT break or cut trees, limbs or bushes.

Refuse/Clean up

- Place all garbage in bags before disposal then place all bags of garbage in designated containers
- Recycle clean cardboard, glass and recyclable cans
